Policy Proposal and Development

1. When it becomes necessary for Research Workers United to enact a new policy, the Executive Board will motion to assign one of its constituent members to draft and propose the language to the rest of the Board at earliest convenience. This member should have a vested interest or expertise in the subject matter of the desired policy.
2. The Executive Board may suggest alterations to the policy's language before motioning to either enact or reject the policy. A $\frac{2}{3}$ majority vote shall be required to approve or reject a policy. Rewritten policies shall be shared at the following Board meeting. Rejected policies require a new motion to begin the process from Step 1.
3. Once enacted, a policy can be amended by a $\frac{2}{3}$ vote.
4. Policies will be posted publicly for the membership to read at earliest convenience.
5. Policies should include in the header: date assigned for creation, date presented to Executive Board, and results of the vote.
